(4) It should be noted that the message for modification confirmation is called “Modify confirm (MOC)” in this Standard, as this Standard conforms to the Recommendation Q.2725.2 approved at ITU-T SG11 plenary meeting in July 1996, whereas the second editions of Q.2762 and Q.2763 approved at ITU-T SG11 plenary meeting in November-December 1999 change the name of the message to “Connection available (COA)”.
