

JT-Q733 Signalling procedure for Call completion supplementary services

"Call Hold(CH)" conforms to the draft text for Recommendation Q.733.2 studied at the ITU-T SG11 editing meeting in November 1991. "Terminal Portability(TP)" conforms to Recommendation Q.733.4 studied at the ITU-T SG11 meeting in March 1992. "Completion of calls to busy subscriber(CCBS)" conforms to the draft recommendation Q.733.3 studied at the SG11 meeting in May 1998.
