1. Relations with international standards

This standard is based on the ITU-T Recommendation Q.920 approved at in WTSC-93 in May 1993.

2.Summary of departures from ITU-T Recommendations

This standard deviates from the above ITU-T Recommendation concerning the following point: The above ITU-T Recommendation specifies an option of either (a) initialization to the default values or (b) initialization based on the values of negotiations with the peer using an XID frame, for initializing the link parameters necessary to connect the layer 2 peer-to-peer information transport. (See ITU-T Recommendation Q.920, 4.4, 5.)

TTC adopts (a) initialization to the default values as the standard method. Summary for JT-Q921, 2-(1) gives the reasons and supplementary explanations.
